Mission Statement

The Carey Marie LeSieur Scholarship program is administered by the Carey LeSieur Foundation, Inc., a private, nonprofit, charitable corporation chartered in the state of North Carolina. The primary mission of the Carey LeSieur Foundation is to provide financial assistance to young women and men who are actively engaged in a course of study, which will lead to a career in healthcare.

Scholarship Oversight

The Carey LeSieur Foundation is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors. The Memorial Scholarship is administered by a Scholarship Committee, which reports to the Board of Directors. The Scholarship Committee is responsible for determining the eligibility criteria of applicants, reviewing all applications and letters of recommendation of qualified individuals and recommending which applicants should be invited for an interview. All decisions about the number and size of the scholarships to be awarded in any given year will be made by the Board of Directors, based on the quality of the applications received and the availability of funds.

Eligibility Criteria

Anyone may apply for a Carey Marie LeSieur Memorial Scholarship who is:

1. a resident of Hatteras Island;
2. currently enrolled and in good-standing, in an accredited post-secondary educational institution; and
3. has completed at least two years of course work leading to a career in a healthcare field. (excluding dentistry and veterinary medicine)

The Application Process

Applicants must submit a completed application along with the requisite transcripts and letters of recommendation. Applications will be reviewed and evaluated by the Scholarship Committee. Finalists will be required to participate in an interview with the Scholarship Committee and members of the Board of Directors. The Scholarship Committee and/or the Board of Directors reserve the right to ask for such further information, from or about any applicant, as it may need in order to make a final decision. Completed applications should be received by the Scholarship Committee **no later than April 17.**

Scholarship Awards

All applicants will be informed, by mail, of the Board's decision. Award recipients will be informed of the amount of the award. The scholarship award will be sent directly to the educational institution. Award recipients will be required to provide the necessary address and any other pertinent information.

They should be people who are familiar with your character, accomplishments and life-goals, and who can attest to any attributes, which may commend you as a potential recipient of a Carey Marie LeSieur Memorial Scholarship.

When you have selected the two people who will write a recommendation for you, give each of them one of the Recommendation Forms (found in the application packet) and a pre-addressed envelope, so that they may send their recommendation directly to the Scholarship committee.
